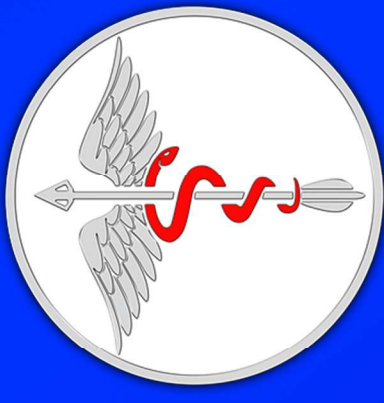

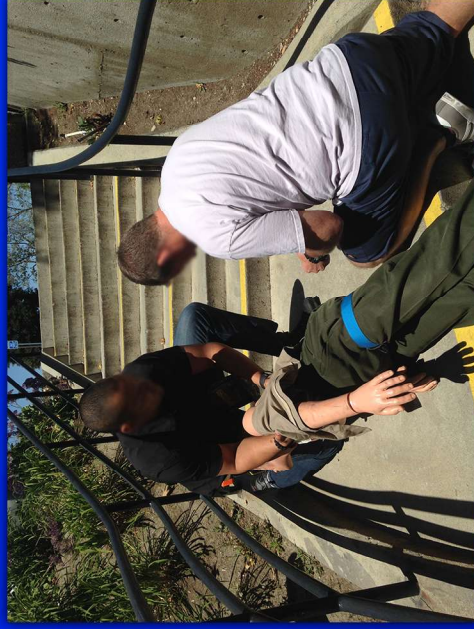

TECC-LEO - Tactical Emergency Casualty Care for Law Enforcement Officers

This 8 hour course teaches the concepts of rapid critical trauma care, as established by the Committee for Tactical Emergency Casualty Care, the American College of Surgeons' Hartford Consensus, and the National Association of EMTs.

These principles provide the law enforcement responder with the critical skills to effectively intervene and mitigate the loss of life following a traumatic emergency incident.

Critical injuries can be fatal in less than 5 minutes. This course teaches the skills to stabilize critically injured victims, law enforcement officers or civilians, and to keep them alive until advanced medical help arrives.



Learn these critical skills with hands-on training and practical application scenarios:

- Threat response protocols of TECC.
- How to perform a rapid trauma assessment.
- How to recognize life-threatening injuries.
- How to treat massive bleeding using tourniquets, hemostatic dressings, and pressure bandages.
- How to treat and manage airway issues.
- How to treat and manage lung compromise.
- How to treat and manage penetrating chest wounds using occlusive chest seals.
- How to care for traumatic shock, hypothermia, and head injuries.
- How to treat and manage traumatic burns.
