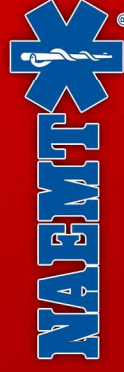

## Swift Action for Emergency Trauma Incidents

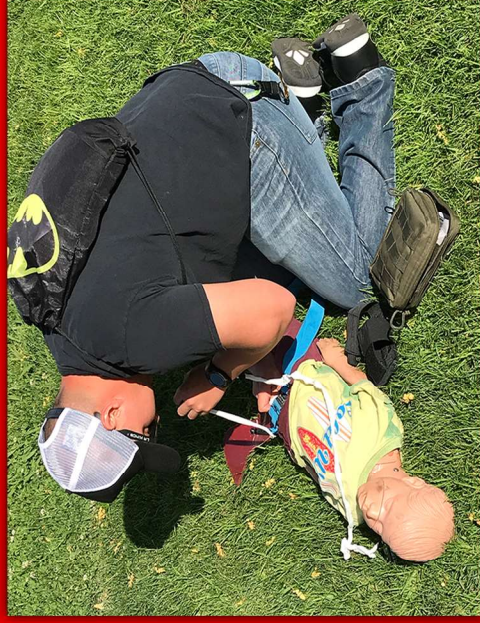


This 4-hour course teaches the concepts of rapid critical trauma care, as established by the Committee for Tactical Emergency Casualty Care, the American College of Surgeons' Hartford Consensus, and the National Association of EMTs.

These principles provide the first responder with the critical skills to effectively intervene and mitigate the loss of life following a traumatic emergency incident.

Law enforcement and EMS response will be delayed. Critical injuries can be fatal in less than 5 minutes. This course teaches the skills to stabilize critically injured victims and keep them alive until advanced medical help arrives.
